<b>All Working</b>	All participants that are found working in the TWC UI wage records, military, USPS (US Postal Service) and OPM (Office of Personnel Management) databases and participants who are working at the same time going to school
<b>All Enrolled</b>	All participants that are found enrolled in a higher education institution and participants who are working at the same time going to school
<b>Enrolled Only</b>	Participants found enrolled in a higher education institution but not working
<b>Graduates</b>	Graduates during 200X-200Y academic year
<b>Graduate Completers</b>	Students graduating a graduate program during 200X-200Y academic year (for universities and HRIs only)
<b>Leavers</b>	Non-returning students enrolled during Summer (I or II), Fall 200X, Spring 200Y, and did not enroll in Fall 200Y at the same institution
<b>Not Located</b>	Participants not found in the employment records or in the THECB database
<b>Undergraduate Completers</b>	Students graduating an undergraduate program during 200X-200Y academic year (for universities and HRIs only)
<b>Working only</b>	All participants that are found working in the TWC UI wage records, military, USPS (US Postal Service) and OPM (Office of Personnel Management) databases but not enrolled in higher education
