Meet at Periodicals section. Show Dental Hygiene periodicals. How organized. Articles found through computer databases, either will be full text, or will be abstracts with citations, find full text articles in periodicals section.

Go to RK60 section, main spot for DH books, RK is overall Dentistry subject.

Go to computer lab.

Log in to computers, TC Home page, point out WEB MAIL (check web mail for library notices) and link to Library.

1. **Brochure** Hours, ILL, Texshare

2. **DH Journal list** Titles in CAPS, bound means we have journal in paper format followed by our holdings by date range; all titles will be Indexed in MEDLINE or CINAHL, many will have full text in one or both databases.

Some will have a note line for Website, which means that full text is available from an online source.

3. **Databases:**

Links to databases are listed on this page.

Scroll to bottom of page until you see ONLINE JOURNAL ACCESS.

Click on the link to the Online Journals page. When doing this off campus, you will have to enter your user name and password after clicking.

You would go to this section for full text journal article access from home, or on campus. You can tell which journals have online access by looking at the Journals handout. This is a way to go to a journal for full text. There are other ways to get full text from other journals by looking in databases like Academic Search Complete, CINAHL and MEDLINE.

Click on the link to **Journal of Dental Hygiene**.

To get the most recent issues online, you have to go to the online journal page.

The issues available are linked off this page. You could click on an issue and browse through it, or you can search for topics in the Journal.

To search for topics, do NOT use the quick search; it will bring up articles other than in JDH that we can't access. Instead, click on advanced search.

In the Search For box, type in **Infection Control**
In the Publication box, type in **Journal of Dental Hygiene**
Click on **EXACT TITLE**
Search
Article list displays

Choose one and click on the link to the article.

Toward the bottom of the screen you see buttons that allow you to open the article in either PDF or HTML format. Click on HTML to open the article.

Click on the home icon in the browser to get back to TC homepage.

Library – databases -- health sciences.

The last search allowed you to go to an online source for full text. But, we have more issues of JDH in the library than the online source gives you access to. If you want to find out what other articles might be available, you can use another database to check for citations, and then come to the library and pull the journal from the shelf and find the article. To find citations for JDH, we will use the database called MEDLINE.

Click on MEDLINE

To find citations to articles in one or more selected journals:

- a. click on Publications
- b. In the Browse Publications box, type in the name of a journal. In this example use Journal of Dental Hygiene.
- c. Click on Browse button
- d. Journal of Dental Hygiene displays at the top of the list.
- e. Click on the empty box to the left of the journal title.
- f. Notice that there are other dental journals near JDH, if you wanted to you could select as many other journals by clicking on the check box as you wished to search from.
- g. Click on the ADD button.
- h. Look toward the top of the page, and you see JDH is in the Find box. Click on the search button.
- i. you now have over 500 articles from JDH to search.
- j. click in the empty search box and type the word “plaque”
- k. click on the search button. 29 articles.

Click on the link to TEMPLE COLLEGE at the top of the page. Click on the Health Sciences link. Click on MEDLINE.

To find articles in all the Dentistry journals that TC subscribes to, do the following. Remember, many of these will only be citation searches, and you will have to go to the periodicals section in the library to find the journals and then make copies of the articles.

- a. look below the second green horizontal line in the Limit your results section.
- b. click on the box to the right of Temple College Dental Journals
- c. Do not select any other limiters.
- d. Go to the top of the page and click in the first empty search box.
- e. type in Gingivitis
- f. to the right of that box you see “default fields” listed.
- g. click on the arrow and a menu will display. Scroll down and click on TI Title when you see it.
- h. in the empty search box below where you typed “gingivitis” click and type the word “hygiene”
- i. click on search button.

65 articles display.

If you find an article that you want to look at, you can click on the title link, read the abstract, then either go to the library shelf and find the journal or go to our online journals section and check to see if the journal has full text access.

Click on [TEMPLE COLLEGE link-- General Section](#)

Click on the link to [netLibrary](#)

netLibrary is a database of books. These are real, published books that happen to be available through the computer.

Search using Dental Hygiene as the terms in the search box, then click on Search.

Many books display that have the topic words highlighted.

To view a book, click on the view this ebook link.

Table of contents, search box at left, ways to navigate through book at right.

Can set up personal account to save and remember books.

Click on TEMPLE COLLEGE – Health Sciences – Stat Ref!

STAT!Ref is a database of medical dictionaries and other medical reference books. If you need to look up technical information on oral diseases and conditions, or drug information, this is a good database to use.

In the search box, type Dental HYGIENE
Search

Links are to sections of the medical reference books.

4. Catalog

This will be the most direct way to find books held inside the library. When looking for books in the online catalog, usually you would search by subject heading, title, or keyword. But since there is a relatively small number of books dealing with dental hygiene and related topics, I'll show you a quick way to see them all so you can browse the titles in a list.

To find books directly related to Dental Hygiene do the following search:

- a. Click on call number
- b. click in the Find This box and type in RK60
- c. click on search.
- d. all the call numbers that begin with RK will display. These will be books about or directly related to dental hygiene.
- e. when you find one you want, write down the full call number, and go to the shelves and find the book.

click on New Search

Keyword Search:

- a. Type in Dental Hygiene in the search box
- b. Search.
- c. Many will be books that have to do with other aspects of dental health.
