The Curriculum Committee shall have the responsibility to review, evaluate, and approve faculty-recommended revisions to Temple College Curriculum. The Committee is responsible for ensuring the college curriculum is directly related and appropriate to the purpose of the college and the diplomas, certificates or degrees awarded; to the ability and preparation of the students admitted; and to the financial and instructional resources of the college.
