

One Goal – Success for ALL Community College Students

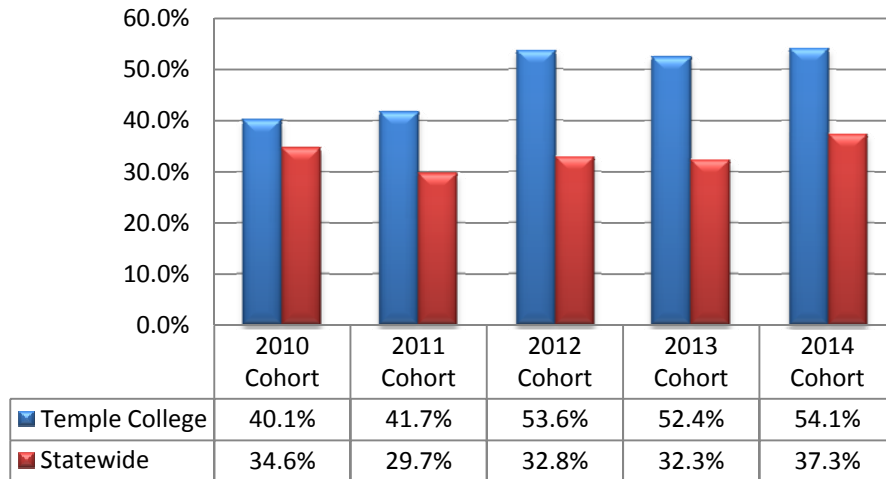

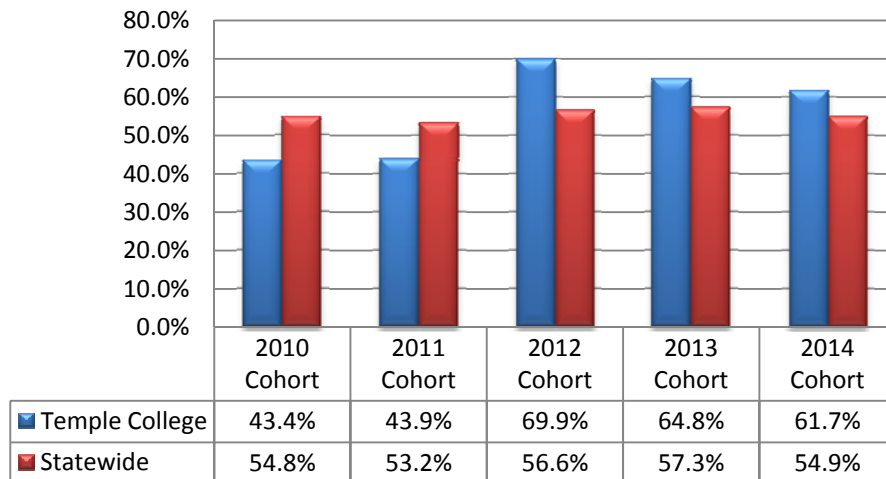

Successfully complete remedial or developmental instruction and advance to credit-bearing courses

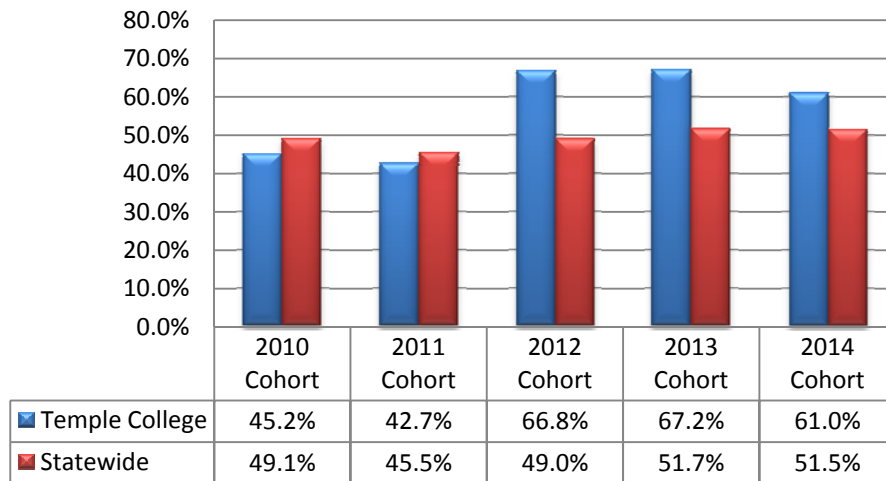
TSI Obligation Met in Two Years-Math



TSI Obligation Met in Two Years-Reading

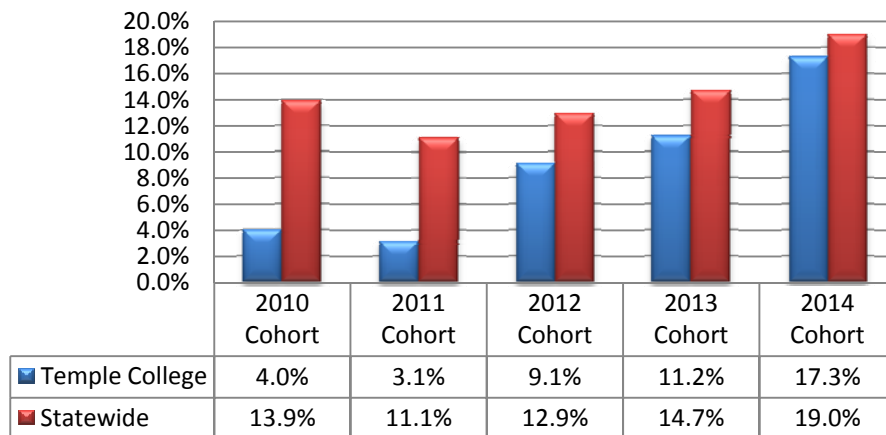


TSI Obligation Met in Two Years-Writing

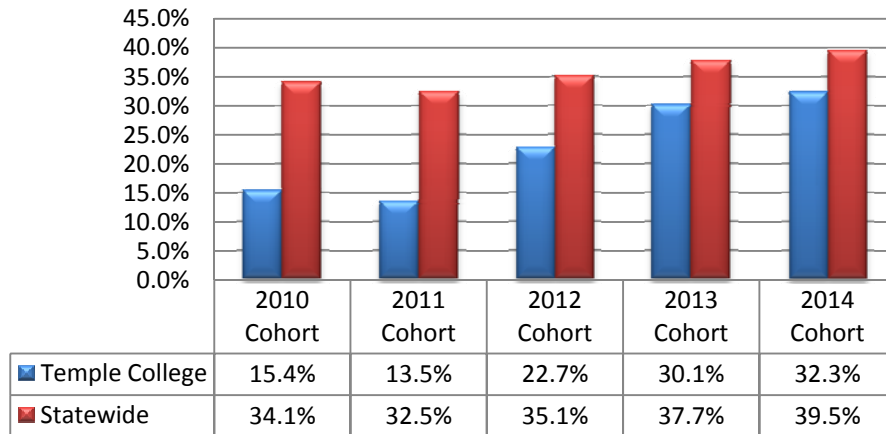


Enroll in and successfully complete the initial college-level or gatekeeper courses in subjects such as math and English

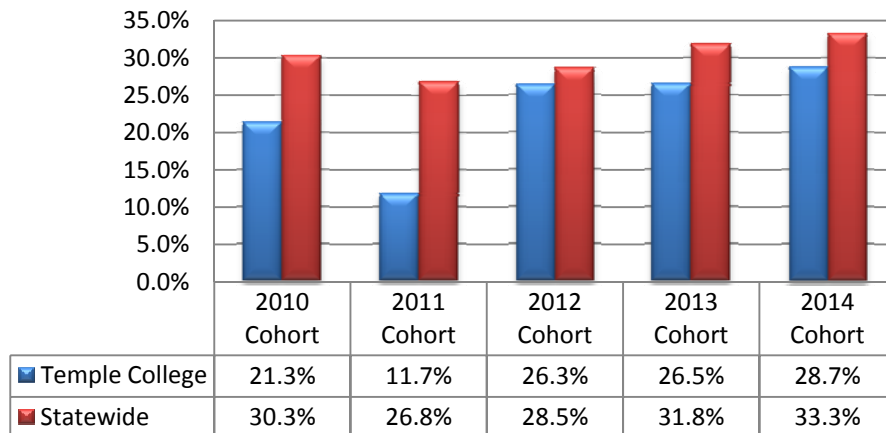
College level Course Completion (A, B, or C) in Two Years-Math



College level Course Completion (A, B, or C) in Two Years-Reading

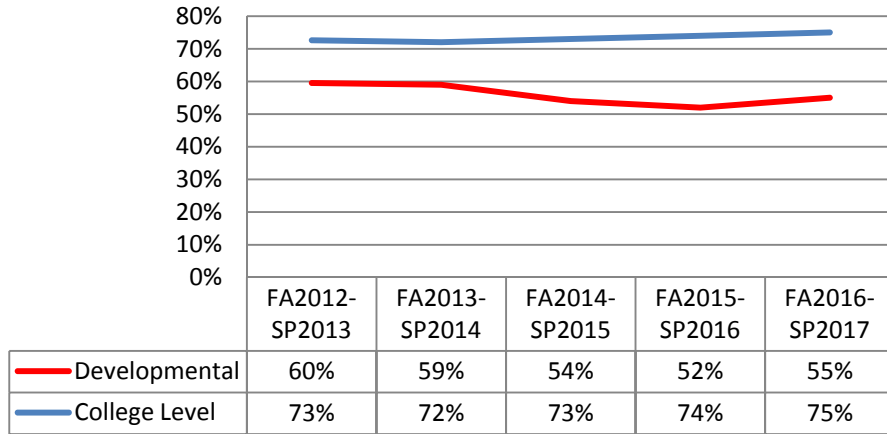


College level Course Completion (A, B, or C) in Two Years-Reading



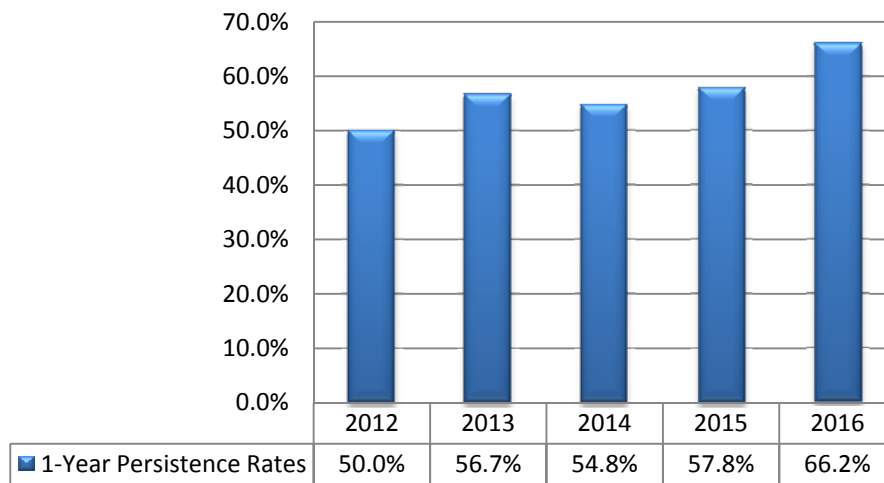

Successful Course Completion A-C



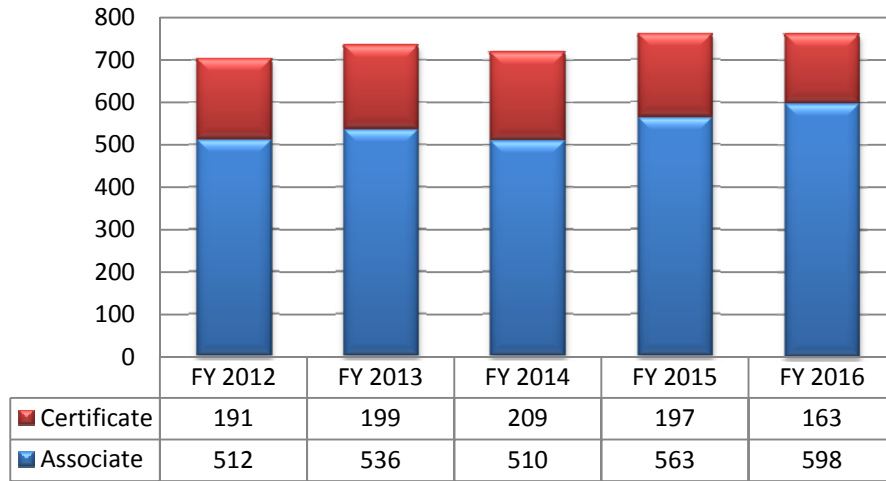
Persistence from one term to the next

1-Year Persistence Rates

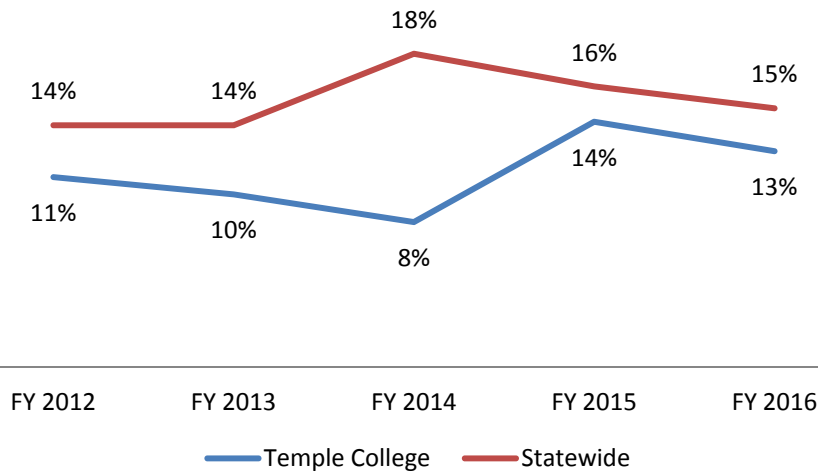

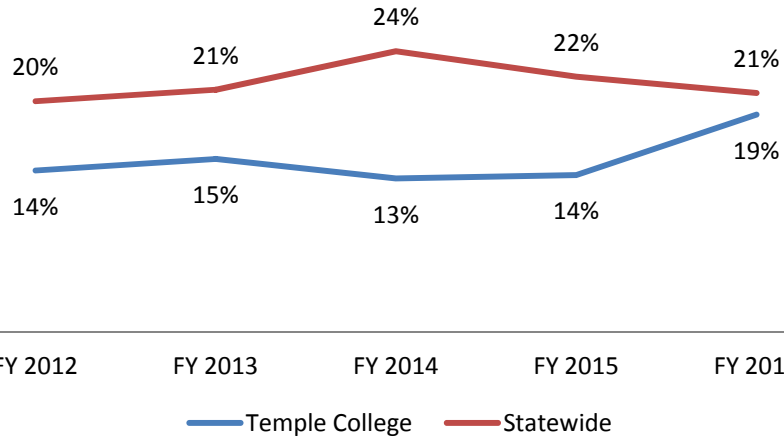
Temple College: Degrees Awarded
