Program Description

The Dental Hygiene program prepares students to be primary oral health care professionals who play a key role in promoting oral health through educational, preventive, and therapeutic services. The curriculum consists of general education, biomedical sciences, dental sciences, and dental hygiene sciences all provided within a framework of academic and clinical experience.

An AAS Degree is awarded upon graduation. Students considering the Texas Woman's University dual enrollment program, to complete a BS in Dental Hygiene, must have core curriculum courses completed. The required math course for the TWU program is Math 1442- Elementary Statistical Methods.

Dental hygienists have employment opportunities in general and specialty dental practices and clinics, pharmaceutical and dental supply companies, community health agencies, education and research institutions, and management settings.
