The first Commencement ceremony will be held Friday, May 13, 2011 at **Hutto High School** Auditorium in Hutto, Texas. The ceremony will start at 7:00p.m. Please report to the FM 685 entrance and follow the signs. Please report by 6:00 p.m.

The second Commencement ceremony will be held Saturday, May 14, 2011 at the **University of Mary Hardin-Baylor**, Frank and Sue Mayborn Campus Center in Belton, Texas. The ceremony will start at 10:00 a.m. Please report to the east entrance, off King Street, by 9:00 a.m. Please inform family and friends that they need to park at the west entrance off University Drive.

There will not be a rehearsal. The day of graduation TC staff will brief you on the ceremony proceedings. Please be on time.

You do not need to RSVP for which ceremony you will attend.

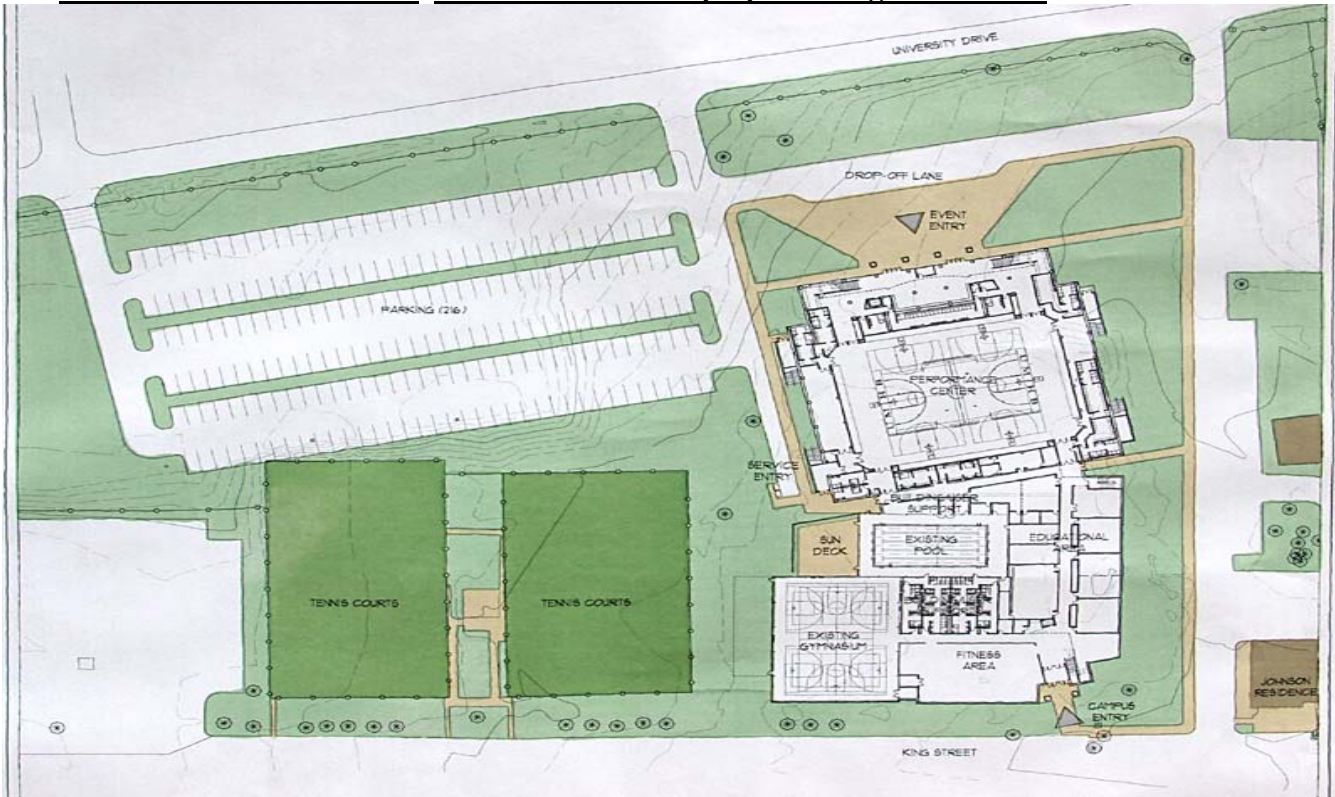

Commencement Instructions

The Commencement Ceremony will be held at the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor Frank and Sue Mayborn Campus Center, Saturday, May 14, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. Graduates are to be at the east entrance located off of King Street at 9:00 a.m. **There will not be a rehearsal. Please be on time for proper seating instructions.**



Directions from Temple

Take I-35 S. to Belton. Exit on 6th Ave. Turn right.
Stay on 6th Ave until light at Main St. Turn right.
From Main St. turn left onto W. 9th Ave (sign will be posted).
From W. 9th Ave., turn right onto King Street. (for graduates only).
Family and Friends will continue on W. 9th Ave to University Drive.

Students may park next to tennis courts and along King Street. You may also park in the overflow lot off Mabee Drive at Parker Drive (if needed). Family and friends need to park at the west lot off of University Drive and will enter from the main (west) entrance.

Hutto High School is located on the southeast corner of HWY 79 and FM 685.

From Taylor: use N. Main Street and HWY 79 as a starting point, travel west on HWY 79 approximately 9.58 miles to reach Hutto High School. The high school is located at the intersection of HWY 79 and FM 685/Ed Schmidt Blvd. Turn left at this light. Turn left into the first entrance of the school campus. This entrance is adjacent to a building which has a scrolling marquee on the side. This building is the Performing Arts Center (PAC). Circle left toward the football stadium and turn right facing the gym. Parking is allowed anywhere in this area. The lobby of the PAC faces the eastside. The eastside faces the football field.

From Round Rock: use IH-35 and HWY 79/Palm Valley as a starting point, travel east on HWY 79 approximately 8 miles to reach Hutto High School. The high school is located at the intersection of HWY 79 and FM 685/Ed Schmidt Blvd. Turn right at this light. Turn left into the first entrance of the school campus. This entrance is adjacent to a building which has a scrolling marquee on the side. This building is the Performing Arts Center (PAC). Circle left toward the football stadium and turn right facing the gym. Parking is allowed anywhere in this area. The lobby of the PAC faces eastside. The eastside faces the football field.
