REAL ESTATE COURSE OFFERINGS At Temple College at Taylor

Principles of Real Estate I (RELE 1002)
September 14 – 24, 2009 \$135.00
Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
Overview of licensing as a real estate broker or salesperson. Includes ethics of practice as a license holder, titles to and conveyance of real estate, legal descriptions, deeds, encumbrances and liens, distinctions between personal and real property, appraisal, finance and regulations, closing procedures, and real estate mathematics. Covers at least three hours of classroom instruction on federal, state, and local laws relating to housing discrimination, housing credit discrimination, and community reinvestment. Fulfills at least 30 of 60 hours of required instruction for salesperson license.

Principles of Real Estate II (RELE 1039)
October 12-22, 2009 \$135.00
Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
Overview of licensing as a broker or salesperson. Includes ethics of practice as a license holder, titles to and conveyance of real estate, legal descriptions, deeds, encumbrances and liens, distinctions between personal and real property, appraisal, finance and regulations, closing procedures, and real estate mathematics. Covers at least three hours of classroom instruction on federal, state, and local laws relating to housing, discrimination, housing credit discrimination, and community reinvestment. Fulfills at least 30 of 60 hours of required instruction for salesperson license.

Law of Contracts (RELE 1012)

Elements of a contract, offer and acceptance, statute of frauds, specific performance and remedies for breach, unauthorized practice of law, commission rules relating to use of adopted forms, and owner disclosure requirements.

Real Estate Marketing (RELE 1022)

Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
A study of real estate professionalism and ethics; characteristics of successful salespersons; time management; psychology of marketing; listing procedures; advertising; negotiating and closing financing; and the Deceptive Trade Practice Act.

Real Estate Appraisal (RELE 1003)

Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
A study of the purposes and functions on an appraisal, social and economic determinants of value, appraisal case studies, cost, market data and income approaches to value estimates, final correlations, and reporting.

Real Estate Property Management (RELE 1015)

Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
A study of the role of the property manager, landlord policies, operational guidelines, leases, lease negotiations, tenant relations, maintenance, reports, habitability laws, and the Fair Housing Act..

Real Estate Finance (RELE 1020)

Mondays – Thursdays 6:00-9:50pm
An overview of monetary systems, primary and secondary money markets, sources of mortgage loans, federal government programs, loan applications, processes and procedures, closing costs, alternative financial instruments, equal credit opportunity laws affecting mortgage lending, and the state housing agency.

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REAL ESTATE CLASSES FAQ

1. How many classroom hours do I need to get a Real Estate license?
 Applicants after January 1, 2006, need a total of 210 classroom hours to be licensed and a total of 270 hours by the end of their first year of licensure. Temple College offers a total of 224 hours of training within a 7 month period.

2. Does Temple College offer the classes I need to become a licensed Real Estate salesperson?
 Yes. TC offers the four basic classes required for licensure (a total of 128 hours) as well as three other classes so the student may earn 224 classroom hours and take the state licensing exam.

Each of the classes below are 32 classroom hours. The classes offered are:

**Although other classes may be used to fulfill classroom hour requirements, these optional classes are offered in rotation by Temple College at this time.

3. How are classes offered at Temple College at Taylor?
 Classes are offered via videoconference. Students will meet in a classroom in Taylor with a two-way videoconference link to the Temple Campus. Students at both locations will participate in the class.

4. What is the cost of classes?
 Each class costs \$130.00 plus textbooks and is payable to Temple College at the time of registration in check, money order, or by credit card.

5. Where do I get textbooks?
 Textbooks may be purchased at the TCAT bookstore for each class. There is one textbook for the two Principles of Real Estate classes and each of the other classes has its own textbook.
