



Dear Student,

Temple College has received an allocation of funding through the Federal CARES Act for emergency student aid. The College is utilizing that aid to provide \$300 grants to all students enrolled in six or more hours this summer. You are receiving the letter because you are enrolled in at least six hours during the summer term. We are beginning to distribute the funds. You do not need to apply for this grant. Funds will be sent automatically to you through ACH for those who have direct deposit set up or by check and sent to your home address on file.

You may use your grant funds in whatever way best meets your individual needs, but I strongly encourage you to spend the funds on technology or other expenses related to the disruption of campus operations and the shift to online courses this summer due to the coronavirus. If you do not already own a laptop that is compatible with the software required by your courses, you can find one at [www.dell.com/templejc](http://www.dell.com/templejc) or your preferred electronics retailer.

I wish you success this summer as you further your educational goals. However, I realize that your individual circumstances may change. If you have to drop or withdraw from summer course(s), your refund may go back to the grant or you may be ineligible for additional funds.
