- A "Best if Used By/Before" date indicates when a product will be of best flavor or quality. It is not a purchase or safety date. A "Sell-By" date tells the store how long to display the product for sale for inventory management. A "Use-By" date is the last date recommended for the use of the product while at peak quality.
- Temple College and the original donor will be released from any liability or harm or losses in connection with the food or supplies students and employees receive. Students and employees assume any risks and covenant not to sue the released parties with respect to such harm or losses.
