

Transcripts and Transfer Information

- 1) **Official Transcripts:** Ensure that ALL transcripts from your college experiences that include your prereq/coreq classes as well as any nursing courses attended are sent to Admissions and Records admissions@templejc.edu. Please follow up with Admissions and Records to verify your transcript was received.
- 2) **Unofficial Transcripts:** Ensure that ALL unofficial transcripts from ANY colleges that include your prereq/coreq classes, including Temple College, are uploaded as a supplemental item on your application.

NOTE **Must have a minimum of 2.8 GPA to apply. We calculate your GPA on your nursing prerequisite courses and any of the co-requisites that you have completed. We do not use an overall GPA.

- 3) **Course Equivalencies:** You are responsible for ensuring that you have met the Nursing prerequisite requirements, and to determine whether or not the prerequisite and corequisite courses that you have taken at other colleges/universities, and other institutions are equivalent to our Temple College courses, BEFORE you apply to the Nursing program.
 - a. You do this by contacting the Temple College Advising Office at: advisingcenter@templejc.edu. All of your transcripts must have been received by Admissions & Records, in order for them to evaluate your courses.

NOTE Be sure to upload the above items right away, but NO LATER than the application deadline. Without these documents, your application will be incomplete, and will not be processed. The sooner you upload all of your documents, the sooner we can get your name on a Texas Board of Nursing roster to start your background check process and resolve any potential application issues before the application deadline.

- 4) **Nursing Course Failures:**
 - a. Any one nursing course failure within the last 10 years in an RN or VN program will result in a deduction of an admission point.
 - b. If there is a nursing course failure in any program during the three years prior to admission, the applicant will receive one admission only to the Temple College ADN Program.
 - c. The applicant is ineligible for admission/readmission if there are two or more nursing course failures in any program during the three years prior to admission.
 - d. **A nursing course failure is any grade lower than a "C". This also includes "WF" grades.**
- 5) **Transfer Students:** Transfer applicants who have been successful in a nursing school will be considered for admission on a space available basis. Transfer students must apply for admission and be accepted. At that time, courses will be evaluated for transfer.
 - a. Students who have been dismissed from a nursing program for unsafe or unprofessional conduct will be required to provide information regarding the circumstances and be subject to a review to determine eligibility to be enrolled. All nursing courses must be completed within 1 year prior to admission. Any coursework outside of this time frame will not be accepted for transfer. The student will be required to re-enroll in those courses.
