### Program Description

This program prepares the Licensed Vocational Nurse to make the transition into the professional nursing role. Upon completion of the program, graduates receive an Associate of Applied Science degree which qualifies them to apply to take the state licensing exams for registered nursing. The program is fully approved by the Texas State Board of Nursing and is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing. For additional information or application requirements (students must have a current Texas LVN license without stipulations), consult the TC Website or contact the ADN office at 254-298-8666.

### Nursing Notes

Information sessions are held the first Tuesday of each month in the Dell Martin Nursing Education Center at 4 p.m.

Clinical courses require contact hours generally in a range of 9-12 hours per week. Clinical courses may include day, evening, and weekend hours.

At the completion of the last semester of the program credit will be awarded for RNSG 1301, RNSG 1309, RNSG 1331 & RNSG 1360 (12 SCH).
