The Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program leads to an AAS degree and allows the graduate to apply to take the state RN licensing exams. The program is fully approved by the Texas Board of Nursing and is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing. Nursing Notes

Information sessions are held the first Tuesday of each month in the NEC at 4 p.m.

Clinical courses require contact hours generally in a range of 9-12 hours per week. Clinical courses may include day, evening, and weekend hours.

The HESI A2 Entrance exam is required to apply to this program with a minimum score of 80 in each of the three areas tested (reading, vocabulary and math). Check the TC ADN website for dates for testing and application deadlines.
