Program Description

The Surgical Technologist (ST) is a member of the patient care team before, during, and after surgery. The ST prepares the operating room by selecting and opening sterile supplies and functions as the sterile member of the surgical team who passes instruments, sutures, sponges, and other supplies to the surgeon and surgical assistant.
