Program Description

Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) are the entry level provider for EMS agencies. EMTs assess patients, provide basic level care, and transport the patient to the appropriate facility. Student must be certified as an EMT to progress to the Advanced EMT coursework.

Advanced EMTs (AEMT) provide a higher level of patient care, including advanced airway techniques, IV therapy, and a greater variety of medication treatments. The advanced scope of practice of the AEMT requires a greater depth of understanding of anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology.

The Advanced EMT Program consists of one semester of coursework beyond EMT. Those wishing to complete the entire Paramedic Curriculum must complete two additional semesters.

Admission to the EMS program requires a separate application in addition to admission to Temple College. Application requirements for each program are listed in the college catalog. Additional information may be found in the application packet or on the Department website. Enrollment is limited by spaces available for clinical experiences. This program prepares students to take the certification exam to become an Advanced EMT. Call for an appointment 254-298-8697.
